Let us share our 50 years of knowledge and experience in the science of coastal and marine biology, geology, and conservation with your child. It could change his or her life forever.

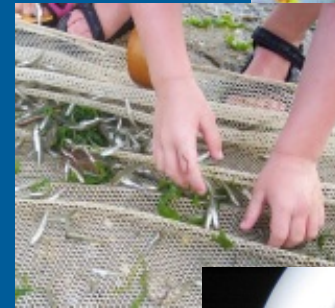
