The position is full time and hours are flexible with some evening and weekends required. This is an excellent opportunity to work with a well-established organization that promotes coastal conservation through education and advocacy.

Qualifications: Junior or senior with marine biology, marine science, coastal ecology or similar background. Some environmental education experience would be helpful but not necessary, as long as you enjoy sharing your enthusiasm for the littoral zone with people from all age groups and walks of life. You must have a basic knowledge of coastal ecosystems and the ability to identify basic flora and fauna and you must have the use of a car.

The Littoral Society offers a paid dormitory room, a stipend based upon experience and education and seeks someone who can begin work in mid to late May 2010. The Society will work with you and your educational institution to meet their requirements to receive college credits for your work with us.
